ROOT WORD:

βασιλεύς (basileus)

MEANING:

KINGDOM, ROYAL POWER, SOVEREIGN RULE

6 DEFINITIONS OF βασιλεία (G932)

-  **1 KINGDOM**
The domain in which a king rules; the realm of royal power and authority.
-  **2 ROYAL POWER**
The exercise of kingly authority and sovereign rule.
-  **3 SOVEREIGNTY**
Supreme rule and dominion; the right to govern and command.
-  **4 REIGN**
The period during which a king reigns; the continuation of royal rule.
-  **5 AUTHORITY OVER A TERRITORY**
Dominion over a people or territory by rightful rule.
-  **6 GOD'S KINGDOM**
The reign and rule of God; His spiritual dominion in the hearts of His people and ultimately over all creation.

To come into existence; to become a reality.
- 🚩 **2 TO BE DONE**
To be accomplished or carried out; to be finished.
- 🎯 **3 TO TAKE PLACE**
To occur or happen as intended or purposed.
- 🔨 **4 TO BE ACCOMPLISHED**
To be effected; to bring to completion; to fulfill.
- 📋 **5 TO BE PERFORMED**
To be executed or carried out in action or deed.
- 👑 **6 TO BE ESTABLISHED**
To be set in place; to be affirmed and confirmed.

MEANING:

FATHER

2 DEFINITIONS OF πατήρ (G3962)

- 1 A PROGENITOR / SOURCE OF LIFE**
The one from whom life originates; the source and origin.
- 2 A NOURISHER, PROTECTOR, AND UPHOLDER**
One who sustains, provides for, and maintains those under his care.

5 CHARACTERISTICS OF A FATHER

- 1 PROVIDER** — Matthew 6:8
Supplies what is needed.
- 2 PROTECTOR** — Psalm 68:5
Covers and defends.
- 3 INSTRUCTOR** — Proverbs 4:1
Teaches and gives direction.
- 4 DISCIPLINER** — Hebrews 12:6
Corrects with purpose and love.
- 5 PRESENT & RELATIONAL** — Matthew 6:8
Engaged, aware, and attentive.

MEANING:

TO KNOW

6 DEFINITIONS OF οἶδεν (G1492)

- 1  **TO SEE WITH PERCEPTION**
Not just physical sight, but full awareness and understanding.
- 2  **TO KNOW ABSOLUTELY / WITH CERTAINTY**
Complete, perfect knowledge — nothing unknown.
- 3  **TO UNDERSTAND INTUITIVELY**
Not learned over time — known immediately and inherently.
- 4  **TO BE AWARE BEFOREHAND**
To already know in advance, prior to the moment.
- 5  **TO PERCEIVE CLEARLY / DISCERN**
To recognize, distinguish, and fully comprehend.
- 6  **TO POSSESS FULL KNOWLEDGE**
Total awareness — nothing hidden, nothing missing.



GRAMMAR INSIGHT

Perfect tense → “He has known and still knows.”

ROOT WORD:

χρεία (chreía)

MEANING:

NECESSITY, NEED, WANT

6 DEFINITIONS OF χρεία (G5532)

-  **1 NECESSITY**
That which is absolutely necessary; a thing needful to sustain life or fulfill a purpose.
-  **2 NEED, REQUIREMENT**
Something that is required; a thing that one lacks and must have.
-  **3 LACK, WANT**
A lack of something essential; wanting that which is not possessed.
-  **4 USEFULNESS, BENEFIT**
That which is useful or advantageous; what is helpful in a given situation.
-  **5 SUPPLY, PROVISION**
That which supplies a want; to provide what is needed.
-  **6 MATTER OF IMPORTANCE**
A thing of importance or concern; a matter that demands attention.
